**For SAT-7 and the Middle East**  
March 2023

**WEDNESDAY 1 MARCH****ETERNAL HOPE**

“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away” (Revelation 21:4). Thank God for the truth that, in the end, He will make all things well.

**THURSDAY 2 MARCH****TÜRKIYE AND SYRIA EARTHQUAKES**

Pray for all those affected by the devastating earthquakes that struck Türkiye and Syria on 6 February. Ask God to heal the injured, comfort the bereaved, and provide for the homeless. Pray for SAT-7 as we offer His message of hope and peace to the suffering.

**FRIDAY 3 MARCH****WESTERN SAHARA**

Tensions remain high in Western Sahara. As its independence is debated, Morocco and Algeria are heavily invested in the outcome. Pray for a peaceful, godly solution to a very difficult situation.

**SATURDAY 4 MARCH****SAT-7 PARS STUDIOS**

At first glance, it may seem strange that SAT-7 PARS' studios are located in Cyprus and London. SAT-7 PARS broadcasts Persian-language programs and is watched primarily by viewers in Iran and Afghanistan. It is staffed mostly by expatriate Iranians, many of whom have had to leave Iran because of their Christian faith. The studio cannot be located in Iran because of religious freedom restrictions there. Limassol and London, home to significant numbers of Iranians, provide strategic alternative locations. Pray for the SAT-7 PARS staff, and ask that one day it will be possible for SAT-7 to have a studio inside Iran.

**SUNDAY 5 MARCH**  
**LENT FOCUS #2**

*Türkiye*



**“Let’s pray for Türkiye; a land where the first Christians appeared. A land so rich with Christian heritage, and yet so forgotten. Pray this Easter for the people of this country, so that they may remember and find their path to their true God, their true father, their Heavenly Baba.**

**“May they no longer feel isolated, in despair and without hope. May they encounter Jesus in their lives and realise that the true God does not manipulate His subjects from above, determining their every move. No. Let them know in the very fibre of their being that the true God lives! He walks with us, among us. He stands with us in face of every trial. And he is never defeated. He is risen! He has done what no man has done. He lived; He served; He suffered; He died. But the story didn’t end there.**

**“Pray that our people feel the same joy that the apostles felt when they first saw the resurrected Jesus. Let the Thomases among us ask for proof, for our God provides us with whatever we need. Pray that we can become truly one in Christ and sit at His table as His children of light.”**

## MONDAY 6 MARCH

### PERSECUTION

This week we'll reflect on some of the countries in the MENA where Christians are persecuted for following Jesus. Today we pray for Iraq, where the country's minority Christian population has been badly affected over many years by conflict and instability. Since Islamic State militants, who gained control of a third of the country in 2014, were driven out, there has been a drop in reported incidents of violence against Christians in Iraq. Pray for this to continue, and that Iraqi Christians can find places to settle and live in safety.

## TUESDAY 7 MARCH

### TAJIKISTAN

The authorities in Tajikistan enforce strict religious laws and allow churches to meet only if they have a permit. New converts must deal with these difficulties as well as pressures closer to home. Christian men and women whose conversions are discovered by their community face beatings, verbal abuse, and social ostracism. Pray that the authorities in Tajikistan will allow more freedoms to Christians in the country, and for the Gospel to spread through entire communities.

## WEDNESDAY 8 MARCH

### SAUDI ARABIA

Many of the Christians in Saudi Arabia are foreign workers. They face discrimination in the workplace and restrictions on gathering for worship and sharing their faith. The very small number of native Saudi Christians have to practise their faith in complete secrecy. Pray for workplace conditions to improve and for Christians in the country to find creative ways to gather and share their faith.

**THURSDAY 9 MARCH****YEMEN**

There are only a few thousand Christians in Yemen, mostly converts from Islam, who must live out their faith in secret because conversion from Islam to Christianity is forbidden. They are also suffering as a result of the civil war and humanitarian crisis in the country. Pray that God will uphold and strengthen Christians in Yemen.

**FRIDAY 10 MARCH****LIBYA**

Just 0.5% of Libya's population is made up of Christians, and converts from Islam face immense pressure from their families and communities. They face being left homeless and jobless and totally ostracised from their community. If they refuse to give up their faith, they could face imprisonment or violence. Pray that more people in Libya would seek God's Kingdom.

**SATURDAY 11 MARCH****AFGHANISTAN**

Afghanistan is considered to be one of the most dangerous places in the world to be a Christian, and since the Taliban took control in August 2021, the situation has only deteriorated. The choice for Afghan converts is stark: flee, hide, or face violence – even death. Pray for those who are suffering for following Jesus and those who are mourning the loss of loved ones. Thank God that He identifies with them in their deep pain.

According to the UN Refugee Agency, three quarters of all households in Syria could not meet their most basic needs in 2021 – 10 percent more than in the year before. Pray that God will have mercy on these families, providing materially and spiritually for them.

## THURSDAY 16 MARCH

### VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Gender-based violence against women in Türkiye continues to be a serious problem. Ask God to comfort those who are suffering, and to inspire people to change the culture from the inside out. Give thanks for SAT-7 TÜRK programs that promote the value of women and raise their aspirations.

## FRIDAY 17 MARCH

### GOD'S PROVISION

Thank God that He has supplied the needs of SAT-7's ministry for almost 27 years and counting. Pray that He will continue to provide the vital financial resources and personnel needed for SAT-7 to continue bringing joy, showing love, and strengthening faith in the MENA.

## SATURDAY 18 MARCH

### SPRING

As spring awakens the natural world, pray that God will refresh your soul and renew your vigour. Ask Him to speak to you about how you could help bring new life to others during this season.

## SUNDAY 19 MARCH

### LENT FOCUS #4

Misconceptions about Christianity are commonplace in Türkiye. Pastor Cem Erçin, presenter of *Essence of the Gospel*, aims to share the message of Jesus in a clear and engaging way. Pray that the program will help many people in Türkiye who are searching for the truth.

## THURSDAY 23 MARCH PRINCIPLES OF FAITH

Live program *Principles of Faith* seeks to help viewers in Iran and Afghanistan understand the Bible through teaching and discussion. Pray that viewers will learn more about the Christian faith through this program.

## FRIDAY 24 MARCH POWER OF PRAYER

*Power of Prayer*, presented by Ayda Danacıoğlu, exists to deepen the prayer lives of Turkish viewers. Even non-Christians send in prayer requests! Pray that viewers will recognise God’s work in their lives.



## SATURDAY 25 MARCH

### CHURCH4AFGHANISTAN

This live weekly program – available on Facebook and Instagram – is presented by Noorullah Noor, an Afghan assistant pastor living in Germany. Noorullah, along with different Afghan guests, explores biblical topics as well as the current situation in Afghanistan. Pray for the SAT-7 PARS team as they seek to help meet the needs of the persecuted Christians in Afghanistan through this live social media program.

## SUNDAY 26 MARCH

### LENT FOCUS #5



**“My prayer for Iran and the people of Iran is this: just as Jesus promised us that with His death our sins will die with Him, with His resurrection, we will rise with Him and be born again. Open the eyes of my country, Iran, which is drowned in sin and dead in spirituality.
